Karen/English New Testament

Chrestos is in the process of reprinting the Karen/English New Testament with another 4,000 copies. The first printing sold out very quickly, and Karen in many countries did not get any. We are also publishing a new edition of this Karen/English version with headings, references, notes, a glossary and maps. We hope that the sale of each publication will pay for the next. Crossway gave us a license to use the ESV text and The Myanmar Bible Society gave us a license to use the Mason Karen text. SIL has given us consultancy support and enabled us to acquire the Paratext software. Scottsdale Bible Church in Arizona will kindly give to us the proceeds of the sale of the first printing for subsequent publishing.

During the month of October, we are looking forward to the visit of Rev Khoi, the General Secretary of the Myanmar Bible Society, and Mr Arun, who is Regional Director for the United Bible Societies.

Tony Wales (co-founder of Lion Publishers), who has given us much support and help, will visit to give several days of training. Then three of us will go to Hong Kong for the MAI-Asia Publishing Forum [Nov7-11] organized by the Media Associates International. This is encouraging and forming an international network of Christian publishers, editors and writers.

Our studio is embarking on a new evangelistic film in Karen written by Tha Hser Minn, our studio director. Last month a team of trainers supplied by Project Video, came for a few days to help train our camera men and other workers in the film. .

I am the youngest of seven children. When I was young my mother died, and then my father became a Buddhist monk. My older brother is a drug addict. I did not know where to go or where to stay. News from Laos: Children's Seminar



Many seminars are now held inside Laos for the Khmu men, women, and children. They come from far distances to feed on God's Word.

About 123 children attended a 2 day seminar arranged especially for them. Each one paid attention as the Khmu Team taught them. They were hungry for God's Word, and asked the teachers not to stop. The teachers continued until 1:00 a.m., with no time to even take a shower! Then they had a short rest. The children came back at 5 a.m. with their books and pens, waiting for the teachers to get up and teach them again.

The Courage of the Children

Please pray for eleven orphans in Luang Prabang, Laos. They are facing tremendous problems from the principal of the school, who is trying to make them renounce their faith and stop them going to church. Seven have said that they would not go to church anymore but have not yet renounced their faith. Four are standing strong and said they would not renounce their faith and would keep going to church. Their ages range from 9-11.
